

Job Opening: Worship Leader(s), St. Edward's Episcopal Church, San Jose, CA

After a period of transition, St. Edward's is looking to plant a new congregation in the Episcopal tradition that will worship using modern Episcopal liturgy and a blend of upbeat traditional and contemporary music. We are specifically targeting the service to appeal to those 30 to 50 years old who appreciate both ancient liturgy and contemporary music. The Worship Leader(s) will be part of the Planting Team for this new congregation and will be in charge of all music and, in collaboration with the Priest-in-Charge, shape the worship experience in order to appeal to the intended audience. The first service for this new congregation will be September 5 and the Worship Minister would begin no later than August 15. Note: Originally we were seeking a single Worship Minister. We have modified that description to accommodate a small group.

Required Skills

- Experience with keyboard and/or guitar.
- Familiarity with modern worship music.
- Experience leading group singing.
- Desire to work as part of a ministry team.
- Affinity for liturgical worship.
- Ability to teach and train others.

Desired Skills

- Enough experience with keyboard to substitute for our organist as needed for the earlier service.
- Passion for reaching out to the world with God's love through music.
- Familiarity with CCLI SongSelect and other computer-assisted music sources.

Salary will be a total of \$600 per month for estimated 5 person-hours per week position. Hours and salary will be expanded as needed for growing service. There will be a review after 90 days and annually thereafter.
